SPVMHC has added Vivitrol treatment in Highland County. Will take as many people as they can get. SPVMHC also reports IOP is up and running in Highland Co. It was reported that Lyft is operational in Highland Co. Bill from Paint Valley ADAMH Board discussed Medication Disposal Bags for coalition to distribute, revisited Paint Creek facility.

**General Meeting**

There was an introduction of those in attendance and overview of business meeting.

Monica Baucher gave an overview presentation of Lynn Goff Clinic in Greenfield. Two people in recovery shared their experiences. 50 ladies have been in the program to date. Of those 13 have completed treatment. 16 were self-referral with 16 leaving prior to completion. 34 were referred from probation with 10 leaving treatment prior to completion. There are currently 9 ladies in the home. The clinic addresses dual-diagnosis needs
